

WELCOME TO MALMÖ

Famed for its extremely continental character and multicultural appeal, the Swedish city of Malmo cannot help but be influenced by Denmark's nearby capital of Copenhagen, which lies across the water and is linked by the spectacular Oresund Bridge, Europe's longest bridge combining both road and rail. It is Sweden's third largest town with a population around 300.000, and a district (Skåne province) with about 1.000.000. The skyline of Malmo is particularly interesting and rather extraordinary, since the city seems to be filled with some rather unusual structures, such as the hard-to-miss Turning Torso tower, which twists its way high into the sky.

The very heart of Malmo is based around the Old Town district, which is known as the Gamla Staden and surrounded by a scenic canal. This is also where the conference hotel is located. Within Malmo's Gamla Stan are three notable squares, surrounded by interesting shops and appealing restaurants.

Öresund Bridge



A decade has passed since the Øresund Bridge opened to traffic. The vision is to establish the Øresund Region as a powerhouse that will make the region even more attractive to visit, live and work in. The business concept is for the Øresund Bridge to build new bridges day by day – economically, culturally and psychologically. The Bridge must be the best way of reaching destinations on the other side of Øresund.

On our tour to Øresund Bridge, we will have a look of the old town and the area in the west part of Malmö. We will visit the Bridge and the control tower, controlling the traffic on the Bridge between two countries.

Dragør in Denmark



We will pass the Bridge and arrive to the Danish city Dragør. The city is known for its well-preserved village environments of St. Magleby and Dragør. At the same time, Dragør is a modern municipality of residence with a versatile and wide-ranging business life, and a living harbour with fishing boats and recreational vessels. ***We will pass the bridge to visit Dragør in Denmark, and have a look of the nice surroundings.***



Nature Surroundings



Malmö is well known for the green parks and recreation areas, and there are some very nice districts outside the town.

On our way back to Malmö, we will pass one of the nice nature districts – Bokskogen. When the bus stops you will feel the fresh air and (hopefully)hear the birds singing for the spring!

Turning Torso and West Harbour



We will visit architect Santiago Calatrava's spectacular apartment building in the Western Harbour It was completed in autumn 2005 and is Sweden's tallest building with a height of 190 meters, inspiration for the building is taken from a sculpture "Twisting Torso" by Calatrava himself. Turning Torso consists of nine cubes with a total of 54 floors, with the twist from base to peak is 90 °.

The West Harbour waterfront development are fascinating architecture, great promena-des and green spaces and spectacular views of the Sound. Here is an award-winning ecological housing area. There are canals, dams, marinas, and beautiful beaches.

We will have a look from both outside and inside of the Turning Torso building, and visiting one of the apartments for a break and drink before dinner, having a good view of the town/Öresund(depending on the weather). Afterwards, we take a tour trough West Harbour before getting back to the hotel.

Malmö Castle

Castle Malmöhus is the oldest surviving Renaissance castle. By Erik of Pomerania citadel from 1434 are still remnants preserved in the castle, which was completed in 1500-century. Home of the Danish kings during their visit to Malmö and this was also the adventurous Earl of Bothwell, Mary's third husband, imprisoned for five years. The fortress was used 1828-1909 as a prison, and after restoration and renovation was inaugurated Malmö Museum in 1937. Nowadays it is restored and rebuilt and used as a museum.

Swedish Dinner at the Castle

We will visit Borgarstugan in Malmö Castle and have a traditional Swedish Dinner party. The dinner will include a typical Swedish Crayfishparty complete with seafood and Swedish buffet. Wine/beer/traditional schnapps and non-alcoholic drinks will be served.

Swedish songs will be sang by us all together! Dessert: apple cake with vanilla, coffee and aperitif.
